

REVISTAS JURIDICAS EN LOS ESTADOS UNIDOS DE NORTEAMERICA. SITUACION ACTUAL*

1. Función y autoridad.

Hoy día, las publicaciones periódicas juegan un papel determinante en el Derecho. Las revistas jurídicas tienen gran influencia sobre la legislación y la administración, pero su impacto directo ocurre más bien a nivel jurisdiccional, lo que ha venido siendo aceptado desde hace varios años. Ya en 1941 el Presidente de la Corte, Charles Evans Hughes, caracterizó las publicaciones periódicas como el "cuarto estado" del Derecho. La expansión de la literatura jurídica ha ampliado el conocimiento disponible para los tribunales y a menudo la información publicada es utilizada como fundamento de las opiniones judiciales.

Las revistas jurídicas (especialmente las publicaciones de las Facultades de Derecho) son de gran ayuda para los estudiantes de Derecho, principalmente en la preparación de asignaciones y de trabajos de seminario. En ellas se encuentran discusiones y opiniones sobre aspectos jurídicos que no se encuentran en ninguna otra parte, detallados análisis que en muchos casos preanuncian verdaderos tratados jurídicos.

También las revistas jurídicas se consideran de gran ayuda para los abogados practicantes y, especialmente para los investigadores académicos. En ellas se encuentran discusiones que van desde lo elemental hasta lo más complejo. Las nuevas tendencias jurídicas a menudo se manifiestan primero en estas publicaciones periódicas y a veces sólo ahí. También ocupan lugar preferente como foro abierto para la discusión de los tópicos jurídicos, donde se discute la ley tal como es, sus tendencias evolutivas y cómo debería ser.

La autoridad de las revistas jurídicas, por supuesto, es solamente persuasiva. A pesar de que son citadas diariamente en las Cortes, carecen de fuerza vinculante, pero, en concreto poseen gran influencia. Ninguna biblioteca de consulta se considera completa o suficiente sin ellas.

2. Variedades.

Las revistas jurídicas son de diversos tipos, son publicadas bajo diversos auspicios y con diversos propósitos. Las principales modalidades son:

1. *Revistas académicas y de Facultades de Derecho.*

Aunque hay algunas revistas académicas (tales como "Quarterly Review" y "Modern Law Review") que son publicadas independientemente, las revistas académicas típicas en los Estados Unidos son las Revistas de las Facultades de Derecho, patrocinadas por la misma Facultad, pero dirigidas y administradas por un equipo estudiantil.

El estudiante de Derecho se interesa más por la Revista de la Facultad que por cualquier otro tipo de publicación jurídica. Tales revistas son utilizadas por profesores, practicantes y jueces quienes vierten en ellas sus opiniones. Los estudiantes que en ellas trabajan se escogen con rígidos criterios cualitativos.

En términos generales, estas revistas contienen cuatro secciones:

a. Artículos. Aproximadamente la mitad del total de cualquier revista está usualmente ocupado por artículos escritos por profesores, jueces y liti-

gantes. Normalmente en estos artículos se hacen análisis de temas específicos e incluyen amplias citas de autoridad. Tal extenso tratamiento de muchos de estos tópicos no se encuentra en ninguna otra parte.

b. Sección de notas y comentarios. Los estudiantes contribuyen con valiosas notas y comentarios jurídicos. Normalmente están limitados a unas ocho o diez páginas. Se trata de apuntes específicos de temas tales como expropiación, aplicación extraterritorial de las leyes "antitrust", privilegios de funcionarios, etc.

c. Comentarios sobre casos recientes. Normalmente se incluyen unos cinco o seis casos comentados por estudiantes. Estos comentarios concretos son de gran valor porque contienen amplios tratamientos de puntos específicos sobre el significado de pronunciamientos judiciales determinados. Los casos comentados en las revistas se encuentran clasificados desde 1917 en dos índices: el "Index to Legal Periodicals" y "The Social Sciences Citation Index".

d. Sección de reseñas bibliográficas. Tienen gran utilidad informativa estas reseñas; sin embargo, debido al tiempo que transcurre entre la publicación del libro y la de la revista se consideran de menor valor para el estudiante.

Las revistas que publican las Facultades de Derecho enfatizan el estudio del Derecho del propio Estado y de la propia región. A menudo se vinculan con el respectivo Colegio de Abogados. Otras se especializan en campos determinados del Derecho, por ejemplo la "Tulane Law Review" pone énfasis en el Derecho Civil; del mismo modo ocurre con la "Louisiana Law Review". Otras revistas como las de "St. John's University", "Notre Dame" y la de la "Catholic University of America" enfatizan bastante en Derecho canónico. En otros casos encontramos revistas especializadas en Derecho de aviación, Derecho tributario, Derecho penal y Derecho laboral.

También en las Facultades de Derecho se publica lo que se denomina "Intramural Law School Review", que es más bien un boletín compuesto enteramente de notas y comentarios escritos por estudiantes, generalmente seleccionados entre los mejores trabajos presentados en los diversos cursos.

2. *Revistas especializadas propiamente dichas.*

Diversas Facultades de Derecho actualmente patrocinan más de una revista jurídica. General-

mente, estas revistas adicionales están dedicadas a campos concretos del Derecho. Las primeras revistas de esta modalidad fueron "Duke University's Law" y "Contemporary Problems". Desde entonces el número de tales publicaciones periódicas ha aumentado a más de treinta. Además, algunas Facultades patrocinan una sola revista dedicada a un tema específico, por ejemplo "The University of Louisville's Journal of Family Law".

Es frecuente que en las Facultades donde se patrocina más de una revista exista siempre una publicación de Derecho Internacional. Otras áreas frecuentemente representadas son Derecho de Familia, Derecho Comercial, Derecho Tributario y Derecho Constitucional. En general se consideran imprescindibles para los especialistas en estos campos.

3. *Revistas jurídicas profesionales.*

Se denominan así las revistas de asociaciones de profesionales. Así para los profesores de Derecho existe "The Journal of Legal Education" y "The Journal of the Society of Public teachers of Law". Las revistas de los Colegios de Abogados tienen un sentido un poco más práctico y también están clasificadas en el "Index to Legal Periodicals". Diversas secciones de la "American Bar Association", tales como la sección de Derecho Administrativo, la sección de Derecho Laboral, la sección de Derecho Público, tienen sus propias revistas. De gran importancia para los practicantes del Derecho Administrativo son, por ejemplo, el "Journal of the Patent Office Society" y el "I.C.C. Practitioners Journal".

4. *Periódicos jurídicos.*

La principal función de estos periódicos o boletines es la de mantener al día a los practicantes. Frecuentemente contienen reportes sobre temas de interés local. Algunos de ellos son órganos oficiales de tribunales. Ejemplos de boletines locales son el "New York Law Journal", el "Washington D.C. Law Reporter" y el "Chicago Law Bulletin". En 1978 el "National Law Journal" y el "Law times" iniciaron su publicación como boletines para todo el país.

5. *"The U.S. Law Week".*

Esta publicación periódica tiene relación principal con las nuevas leyes y los nuevos pronunciamientos de la Corte Suprema de Justicia. Contiene asuntos de interés general.

a) *"Sections of the United States Law Week"*.

Se trata de un panfleto periódico, consistente de una sección no numerada de leyes federales y de otras cuatro secciones numeradas. Según afirma su Director la sección no numerada se refiere sólo a las leyes de interés general que aprueba el Congreso. La sección número uno es el sumario y el análisis, es un comentario de unas cuatro páginas. La sección dos publica una selección de decisiones federales y de Cortes estatales. La sección tres contiene información de diversos tipos sobre las actividades de la Corte Suprema de Justicia. La sección cuatro contiene el texto completo de las opiniones de la Corte.

b) *"Indices"*.

El "U.S. Law Week" tiene dos índices. Se hacen también índices acumulativos cada dos meses y al final de cada volumen. Estos índices se hacen por materias, autores, nombres de casos, etc.

3. Reseñas de artículos de revistas.

El "Law Review Digest" es una publicación bimestral que presenta notas sobre artículos de una amplia variedad de revistas jurídicas con énfasis en los aspectos prácticos del ejercicio del Derecho. Tiene además un índice por materias que cubre artículos no reseñados. Anualmente se hace un índice acumulativo.

Hay diversas publicaciones donde se reseñan artículos sobre temas especiales. "Commerce Clearing House" publica, por ejemplo, "Federal Tax Articles".

Estas reseñas de artículos son un recurso muy útil para quien no tiene acceso a los mismos artículos. Dado que la información de notas al pie no se incluye en la reseña, se aconseja siempre consultar el artículo original.

4. Indices de Revistas Jurídicas.

Casi todas las revistas jurídicas tienen índices por volúmenes, junto a los índices acumulativos. Existen muchos índices que cubren diversas revistas por temas, autores y títulos.

Veamos algunos:

1. *El índice "Jones-Chipman" de publicaciones periódicas.*

Los primeros tres volúmenes del índice cubren

el periodo anterior al inicio del índice en 1908. Los tres siguientes son poco usados en las bibliotecas que tienen el "Index to Legal Periodicals", que es, considerablemente, más completo y más actualizado. El índice "Jones Chipman" es un índice por materias y autores, de las principales revistas jurídicas en inglés que va desde 1803 a 1937. La ordenación por materias está alfabéticamente ordenada por temas amplios. Pocas notas y comentarios de casos se encuentran en este índice.

2. *El "Index to Legal Periodicals."*

Este es el más completo índice a las revistas jurídicas en inglés desde 1908 hasta la fecha. Más de 375 de las principales revistas jurídicas estadounidenses, británicas y del "British Commonwealth", muchas publicaciones periódicas de Colegios de Abogados, así como otras judiciales están aquí clasificadas. El material es organizado alfabéticamente por temas según el esquema basado (con permiso de West Publishing Company) en el esquema del "American Digest System".

Las políticas en materia de índices han variado con los años. Las actuales políticas exigen que los artículos tengan como mínimo cinco páginas, mientras que las notas sobre casos, las notas bibliográficas y legislativas deben tener por lo menos dos páginas para ser incluidas. A partir del volumen diecisiete se indican las páginas en que comienzan y terminan los artículos.

3. *El "Index to Periodical Articles Related to Law".*

Este índice, publicado trimestralmente (de enero a octubre), cubre material seleccionado de interés jurídico de publicaciones no incluidas en el "Index to Legal Periodicals" o en el "Index to Foreign Periodicals and Collections of Essays". A diferencia del "Index to Legal Periodicals" no se requiere un número determinado de páginas para que un artículo sea incluido en este índice. El número cuatro de cada volumen es acumulativo. También se hace un volumen acumulativo cada diez años y hay otro índice acumulativo de cinco años desde 1969 hasta 1973. Gran parte de este índice se refiere a campos como economía, sociología y ciencia política, relacionados con el Derecho. Se considera valioso auxiliar de investigación.

4. *El "Index to Foreign Legal Periodicals and Collections of Essays."*

Este índice es producido por el "Institute of

Advanced Legal Studies of the University of London" y la "American Association of Law Libraries".

5. *El "Index to Canadian Legal Periodical Literature".*

Clasifica todas las publicaciones jurídicas canadienses sin requisitos de extensión de páginas. Se hace cada dos meses, y acumulativo cada año y cada diez años.

6. *¿Cómo encontrar los artículos más recientes?*

Normalmente hay un atraso de un mes entre la publicación del artículo y su aparición en un índice. Para encontrar los últimos artículos hay tres fuentes. El "Current Index to Legal Periodicals", publicado por la Biblioteca Jurídica de la Universidad de Washington, semanal. El "Current Legal Periodicals" tiene la página del contenido de cada revista reproducida. El "National Law Journal", ya mencionado, también es semanal, pero no pretende ser omnicompreensivo.

7. *Otros índices de revistas jurídicas.*

Entre ellos podemos citar el "Index to Federal Tax Articles", que es un índice multidisciplinario que incluye contabilidad y economía, además de Derecho. Consiste de tres volúmenes donde se clasifican todos los artículos en materia tributaria desde 1913 hasta mediados de 1974 por temas y por autores y un suplemento que contiene los artículos publicados desde 1974 hasta la fecha.

El "Annual Legal Bibliography" contiene una lista seleccionada de libros y artículos recibidos anualmente por la Biblioteca de la Facultad de Derecho de la Universidad de Harvard. Cada número anual está dividido en cuatro tipos de Derecho: "Common Law", "Civil Law", Derecho Internacional Privado y Derecho Internacional Público. Cada uno de ellos subdividido en varias áreas (como Derecho de Familia, Derecho Comercial, etc.). Así, el investigador puede localizar rápidamente una abundancia de literatura jurídica sobre muchos temas. Todos los meses (excepto julio, agosto y septiembre) el "Current Legal Bibliography" hace listas de los nuevos libros y artículos recibidos por la Biblioteca de Derecho de Harvard.

5. *El acercamiento al Derecho por medio de las Revistas Jurídicas.*

Se considera que encontrar una monografía

específica sobre un determinado tema es mucho más difícil que encontrar casos o leyes, por ser comparativamente pocos. El artículo proporciona amplia información sobre un tema específico.

La mayor parte de los principales artículos se dividen en pequeñas unidades más específicas. Normalmente, la primera parte es la introducción que plantea el problema y a veces da un sumario histórico o bibliográfico sobre el tema. Así, encontrar un buen artículo a menudo permite profundizar el tema con base en las notas al pie, especialmente en tópicos en los que no se ha escrito mucho, como daños por radiación.

1. *Indices por temas.* A menos que se tenga una referencia directa, la investigación comienza normalmente con los índices de revistas, según lo descrito antes.

2. *Indices de autores.* Actualmente se publican conjuntamente con los índices por temas.

3. *"Shepard's Citations".* Este trabajo incluye citas de artículos y de comentarios de casos. Últimamente se han ampliado sus alcances.

4. *"Shepard's Law Review Citations".* Esta publicación actualmente cubre más de setenta revistas jurídicas desde 1947. Los volúmenes se mantienen al día con suplementos.

5. *El "Social Sciences Citations Index"* es también de gran importancia.

6. *"Table of cases".* Una clasificación de casos se puede encontrar en el "Jones Chipman Index", volumen 3, donde se cubre desde 1898 hasta 1907. También en el "Index to Legal Periodicals" desde 1917 hasta hoy. Las diversas revistas jurídicas tienen sus propios índices de casos desde sus primeros volúmenes hasta la fecha. A veces un solo caso importante se encuentra comentado en treinta y cinco diferentes revistas jurídicas.

7. *Referencias de tratados, enciclopedia y anotaciones.*

Las revistas jurídicas son muy frecuentemente usadas y citadas en notas al pie en este tipo de obras. Estas referencias son de gran valor para ampliar el tema.

6. *Índice de revistas jurídicas.*

Se agrega a continuación un índice de las revistas jurídicas de los Estados Unidos.

En este índice se indica con relación a cada revista:

- Nombre,
- Precio (por supuesto sujeto a variaciones),

- Frecuencia de publicación
- Editorial
- Dirección

Esperamos que esta guía sea de utilidad para quien tenga interés en alguna suscripción.
